



*Please be informed: while hosting RMN Wrestling Events, we may be mandated to operate under local facility or city conditions. All attendees must observe and comply. Failure to adhere to the following rules, established in coordination with the Health Department, may result in being disqualified from the tournament or asked to leave the premises. Additional security will enforce these provisions. We are committed to follow the rules to host this event in a safe and secure environment.*

### RMN Events Health-Conscious Management Plan

1. Hand wipes and sanitizer bottles will be available at every mat side table.
2. Only (2) coaches with a wrestler competing, either on the mat and in the hole, will be allowed to enter the floor area.
3. We encourage all wrestlers, including those competing in different sessions, to ONLY attend the session in which they are competing.
4. Please do NOT purchase a Floor Pass if you are a spectator.
5. Spectators/wrestlers/coaches are encouraged to congregate in groups of 10 or less.
6. Only (2) coaches/adults per wrestler allowed at mat side, no exceptions. Once the match is finished, the wrestler and coaches must exit the floor immediately.
7. Seating may be limited; if so, designated End Zone seating is reserved for those purchasing a Floor Pass.
8. Ultraviolet lighting may be used at main entry points.
9. Face masks or shields are optional except where required by the venue or the site.
10. Thermometers may be used to check temperature of all competitors, coaches, officials, and spectators who enter the building.
  - a. Those with over a 100-degree temperature will be designated as unsafe and will not be allowed to participate in or enter the event.
11. Livestream video of all action available through our partner FloEvents to reduce the number of spectators.
12. Every person must exit the building immediately following each session.
13. Each mat surface will be mopped with disinfectant after each competitive session.
14. Mat surfaces, tables, chairs, etc. will be disinfected after each session with ultraviolet lighting. Midday house clearing will further maximize the cleaning process.
15. Sessions reduce the number of spectators and competitors allowed in the building.
16. Tournament equipment exposed to competitors and coaches will be wiped down after each day of competition.
17. These precautions and rules are emailed to each registration prior to the event.
18. Absolutely no congregating will be allowed near or around the mat scoring tables.
